### <u>3rd National Women's Convention of AIBOC</u> <u>To be Held at Patiala, Punjab on 8th October, 2023</u>

In our quest to give fillip to the revolutionary attributes of our lady comrades and also to align it with our effort towards women empowerment, All India Bank Officers' Confederation (AIBOC) in its executive committee meeting held at Kolkata on 6<sup>th</sup> of April, 2023, has unanimously decided to organise the **3rd National Women's Convention** in the radiant heartland of the state of Punjab. The captioned convention is aimed towards fostering women participation in trade union activities and to channelise the "Nari Shakti" towards building a robust and strong edifice of our trade union movement respecting the gender equality and acknowledging equal rights, responsibilities and opportunities for all.

Let the effort mark an indelible footprint in the memories of the participants and their zeal touch new heights making the organisation vibrant in tune to the spirit with which the convention has been ideated.

Our Punjab state committee has been bequeathed with all the responsibilities to make the convention a grand success and your prompt response confirming numbers of delegates and payment of requisite fees shall surely motivate them to stage the event in a befitting manner apart from easing them making accommodation arrangement and other logistic peripherals up to the satisfaction and comfort of all the constituents.
